



Jorge M. F. Carvalho holds a Ph.D. in Economical and Environmental Geology from the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Lisbon (Portugal).

He is a researcher from the LNEG (the Portuguese Geological Survey) since 1991. He was elected twice (2009 and 2012) as a board member of the Associação Valorpedra – the Portuguese Natural Stone Cluster for the Portuguese Association of Natural Stones, and was appointed as member of the board of EDM, SA (a state-owned company for the environmental recovery of abandoned mining sites) during 2014 – 2016.

His main research topic is the exploration and evaluation of industrial minerals and rocks, with emphasis on ornamental stone deposits. He coordinated and participated in several research projects related to the above area of interest. Currently participates in the EU projects MINATURA 2020 and MINLAND, this one recently approved, both related to the safeguard of mineral deposits of public importance in land use planning.
